

A B C D HQ & Bn HQ Coys.PAY.

1. The next and following issues of pay to the Bn in this country will be in EIA currency. This money is issued in note form only and is in the following values:-

20/- 10/- 5/- 2/6 1/-

It will replace the Egyptian currency at present in use.

2. Arrangements have been made to replace the Egyptian currency at present held and this will be collected and handed to the Pay Sgt in Coy lots:

Coy's will note:-

- (a) A roll will be prepared in duplicate showing number name and amount to be exchange of each person from whom money is collected and handed in together with the money before 1200 hrs, Wednesday 6/1/43.
- (b) Individual amounts must be in lots of PT 25, 50, 100, 125, 150 etc. Odd amounts such as PT 5, 10, 20, or 45 cannot be exchange individually but two or three men may pool under orders to make an amount of 25 or 50. There is no limit on the amount to be exchanged by any man.
- (c) Coin will not be accepted for exchange nor will torn or mutilated notes.
