Commanding Officer 28 NZ(Maori) Bn9. DISCIPLINE

Owing to the lack of discipline which has been shown by a section of all ranks of the Bn in creating a disturbance contrary to orders, the following disciplinary measures will come into effect immediately.

(a) Until further notice, NO beer or other intoxicating liquor will be issued by the Bn or brought into the area by any person whatsoever.

(b) Any person creating a disturbance after the time already fixed by R.O.'s (2145 hrs) will be liable to immediate arrest for disobedience of orders. Duty coy will be responsible for producing a guard in such cases.

(c) Only the following Bn vehicles are permitted to move in or about the area between 1730 hrs and reveille, without permission from the Bn Orderly Room.

The Orderly Officer will be responsible to the Adjutant for the enforcement of (a) and (b) and the Transport Officer for (c).
