One often sees petrol being liberally poured into an open tin or even into a small hole in the sand, and a resulting fire which is far bigger than is necessary for the purpose. This practice should cease.

(b) "Such weste is wrong at any time. At the present moment, however, with an extended L of C and overcrowded rds, it is of operational importance to reduce petrol consumption to a minimum.
