Is it a credible source?

Someone that is:

- believable
- reliable
- knowledgeable

Questions to think about when you are checking the credibility of a source.

Written or video source:

- · Look for a name
- Check out the person's profile or search for their name online
- Ask yourself:
 - □ Is this person knowledgeable about this topic?
 - □ Is the source location trustworthy?
 - □ When was it made?
 - □ Is the information up-to-date?

For an interview:

- Are they talking about first-hand experiences?
- If not, how qualified are they on the topic?

For objects/photo/places:

- Who made it?
- When?
- · Why?
- What can we/can't we infer from it?
